

Globes are true maps of the world because there is no distortion of area, direction, or distance that you may find on a flat printed map. With a globe you can see where countries and seas are, in true relation to each other. Your globe is also mounted on an arc and stand so it can be rotated like planet Earth. It is called a 'political globe' because it shows the different nations of the world and their borders in a variety of colours as well some cities, major rivers and oceans.

PARTS:

- Table-top stand
- Globe and arc

Adults please note: You will need a Phillips (cross head) screwdriver (not included) to complete assembly.

ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Remove the screw from the boss on the globe arc.
- 2. Fit the globe arc to the table-top stand. The parts are a snug fit, so you may find this easier if you hold the globe upside down and twist the stand onto the boss. Make sure the boss is fully inserted into the stand.
- 3. Insert the screw through the hole in the base of the stand and tighten using a Phillips (cross head) screwdriver.
