4 X 30 BINOCULARS

When you pick up a pair of binoculars it is like looking through two telescopes at the same time! They are easier on the eyes than a single telescope as there is less eye strain when using both to view objects and scenes. Focusing is achieved by moving the central wheel on the bridge between the two eyepiece tubes. The two halves are hinged so that you can alter the distance to suit your eyes. These binoculars offer you 4 X magnification. There is also an integral compass which you can use to determine the direction of an object you are viewing.
